- 26/055 **Exclusion of the Public and Press** - under Public Bodies (Admission to meetings) Act 1960 (as extended by s.100 of the LGA 1972), the public & accredited representatives of News papers be excluded from the following item of business on the grounds that it involves the likely disclosure of exempt information as defined in Part I of Schedule 12A of the LGA 1972.
1. Resolution - to exclude the press and public as above.

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2. Approved Mileage - Noted that HMRC has now increased the Approved Mileage Allowance Payment (AMAP) rate from 45p to 55p per mile for the first 10,000 business miles per tax year, effective from 6 April 2026 and backdated accordingly.
3. National Salary Award - To note the 3.3% salary award and backdated payments for qualifying staff for the period from 1st April 2026 to 31st March 2027 as agreed by the National Joint Council and in accordance with their employment contracts.
